Kia ora & welcome

Are you still at school but keen to take the next steps in your career?

Ara | Te Pūkenga can help you with that. Dual Enrolment programmes are a great way to earn NCEA credits and get a feel for tertiary study, while you're still at school. By gaining industry-based skills at Ara | Te Pūkenga, you can move ahead faster into higher-level study, an apprenticeship or employment.

As a dual enrolment student, you'll be enrolled at secondary school and Ara | Te Pūkenga at the same time. For the duration of the school year, you'll spend one to two days per week at Ara | Te Pūkenga, and the rest of the week at school with your friends doing your normal school activities. You'll have access to both school and tertiary support services, which helps with a smoother transition into the workplace or education beyond school.

Dual Enrolment programmes are delivered in a variety of flexible ways that can be negotiated with your school to best meet your needs. Even better, they're free if you're in Years 11, 12 or 13.

Places are limited and funding is dependent on availability. Some courses may incur costs, depending on the learner's eligibility.

Eligibility criteria

To enrol you must be in Year 11, 12 or 13 at a secondary school and a New Zealand citizen, permanent resident or hold a visa that allows you to be enrolled in a New Zealand secondary school. If you are interested in enrolling in a Dual Enrolment course, you should first talk to your secondary school or with Ara | Te Pūkenga. As different programmes are offered, entry requirements, application, and interview processes (including selection criteria) may vary.

How to apply

If you are interested in participating in a Dual Enrolment course, you should first talk to your secondary school careers team or with Ara | Te Pūkenga.

To apply, scan and email your completed Ara | Te Pūkenga dual enrolment application form, high school endorsement form, and verified identity documents to enrolmentsupport@ara.ac.nz.
